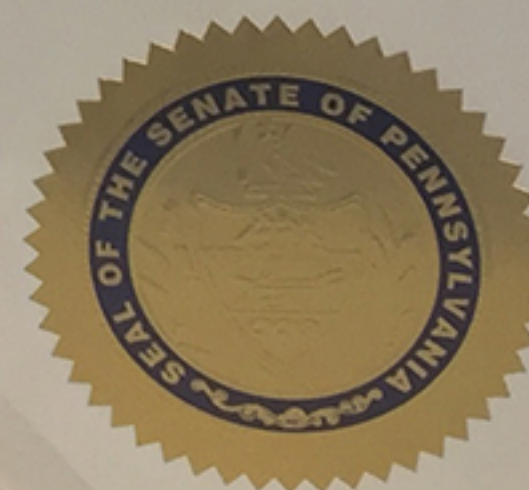


**Whereas**, SimpleFuel is being honored upon receiving the Emerging Technologies Champion of Commerce Award from the Lower Bucks County Chamber of Commerce during its 2017 Champions of Commerce event, which will be held on November 30, 2017; and

**Whereas**, SimpleFuel is an on-site hydrogen generation, compression, storage and dispensing appliance that can be installed in homes, community centers, small businesses and similar locations for fueling hydrogen fuel cell vehicles, small trucks and forklifts. SimpleFuel was designed in response to the H<sub>2</sub> Refuel H-Prize competition, sponsored by the United States Department of Energy and Hydrogen Education Foundation, which challenged innovators to deploy an on-site hydrogen generation system, using electricity or natural gas. SimpleFuel converts one and a half gallons of water into enough hydrogen fuel to allow one fuel cell hydrogen vehicle to travel more than three hundred miles. SimpleFuel is lauded as an integral part of the global hydrogen infrastructure in supporting more transportation energy options for consumers.


